

IMMEDIATE RELEASE BAKERSFIELD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Kern County)

The unemployment rate in Kern County was 7.5 percent in October 2017, down from a revised 8.1 percent in September 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 9.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
